A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to including the qualifications for voting early by mail
- 3 on the ground of disability on certain early voting by mail
- 4 materials.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 52.005, Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 52.005. BALLOT CONTENT DETERMINED ACCORDING TO
- 9 PRECINCT. Except as provided by Section 52.009, the [The] ballot
- 10 for an election precinct may contain only those offices and
- 11 propositions stating measures on which the qualified voters of the
- 12 precinct are entitled to vote.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 52, Election Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 52.009 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 52.009. BALLOT FOR VOTING BY MAIL. A ballot to be
- 16 voted by mail under Chapter 86 must include a statement describing
- 17 the specific circumstances under which a voter may vote early by
- 18 mail on the ground of disability as provided by Section 82.002.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 84.011(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) The officially prescribed application form for an early
- 22 voting ballot must include:
- 23 (1) immediately preceding the signature space the
- 24 statement: "I certify that the information given in this

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- 1 application is true, and I understand that giving false information
- 2 in this application is a crime.";
- 3 (2) a statement informing the applicant of the
- 4 offenses prescribed by Sections 84.003 and 84.004;
- 5 (3) spaces for entering an applicant's voter
- 6 registration number and county election precinct of registration,
- 7 with a statement informing the applicant that failure to furnish
- 8 that information does not invalidate the application; and
- 9 (4) on an application for a ballot to be voted by mail:
- 10 (A) a space for an applicant applying on the
- 11 ground of absence from the county of residence to indicate the date
- 12 on or after which the applicant can receive mail at the address
- 13 outside the county;
- 14 (B) a space for indicating the fact that an
- 15 applicant whose application is signed by a witness cannot make the
- 16 applicant's mark and a space for indicating the relationship or
- 17 lack of relationship of the witness to the applicant;
- 18 (C) a space for entering an applicant's telephone
- 19 number, with a statement informing the applicant that failure to
- 20 furnish that information does not invalidate the application;
- 21 (D) a space or box for an applicant applying on
- 22 the ground of age or disability to indicate that the address to
- 23 which the ballot is to be mailed is the address of a facility or
- 24 relative described by Section 84.002(a)(3), if applicable;
- (E) a space or box for an applicant applying on
- 26 the ground of confinement in jail to indicate that the address to
- 27 which the ballot is to be mailed is the address of a relative

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1 described by Section 84.002(a)(4), if applicable;
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- 2 (F) a space for an applicant applying on the
- 3 ground of age or disability to indicate if the application is an
- 4 application under Section 86.0015;
- 5 (G) spaces for entering the signature, printed
- 6 name, and residence address of any person assisting the applicant;
- 7 (H) a statement informing the applicant of the
- 8 condition prescribed by Section 81.005; [and]
- 9 (I) a statement informing the applicant of the
- 10 requirement prescribed by Section 86.003(c); and
- 11 (J) a statement describing the specific
- 12 <u>circumstances under which a voter may vote early by mail on the</u>
- 13 ground of disability as provided by Section 82.002.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 86.013(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (d) The following textual material, as prescribed by the
- 17 secretary of state, must be printed on the reverse side of the
- 18 official carrier envelope or on a separate sheet accompanying the
- 19 carrier envelope when it is provided:
- 20 (1) the prohibition prescribed by Section 86.006(b);
- 21 (2) the conditions for delivery by common or contract
- 22 carrier prescribed by Sections 81.005 and 86.006;
- 23 (3) the requirements for the legal execution and
- 24 delivery of the carrier envelope, including the prohibition on
- 25 compensation for depositing carrier envelopes containing ballots
- 26 voted by other persons under Section 86.0052;
- 27 (4) the prohibition prescribed by Section 86.006(e);

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- 1 [and]
- 2 (5) the offenses prescribed by Sections 86.006(f) and
- 3 86.010(f); and
- 4 (6) a statement describing the specific circumstances
- 5 under which a voter may vote early by mail on the ground of
- 6 disability as provided by Section 82.002.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
