A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT

- 2 relating to content, issuance, and change of driver's licenses and
- 3 other forms of identification issued by the Department of Public
- 4 Safety, including automatic voter registration.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 507.001(b), Business & Commerce Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) This section does not affect:
- 9 (1) the requirement to display a handgun license under
- 10 Section 411.205, Government Code[, that a person subject to that
- 11 section present a driver's license or identification certificate in
- 12 addition to a concealed handgun license]; or
- 13 (2) the types of identification required under federal
- 14 law to access airport premises or pass through airport security.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 1.005, Election Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subdivision (4-a) to read as follows:
- 17 <u>(4-a) "Driver's license" includes a commercial</u>
- 18 <u>driver's license.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
- Sec. 13.009. VOTER REGISTRATION THROUGH DEPARTMENT OF
- 22 PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) The voter registrar of each county shall
- 23 automatically register any county resident who is eligible to vote
- 24 as provided by Section 13.001 and:

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- 1 (1) is issued an original or renewal Texas driver's
- 2 license or a personal identification card by the Department of
- 3 Public Safety; or
- 4 (2) makes a change to a Texas driver's license or
- 5 personal identification card issued by the Department of Public
- 6 Safety.
- 7 (b) A driver's license or personal identification card
- 8 transaction with an indication provided by Section 20.062(b) or
- 9 20.063(c) that the transaction is not for voter registration
- 10 purposes is not subject to this section.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 20.061, Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 20.061. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER PROVISIONS. The other
- 14 provisions of this chapter apply to the Department of Public Safety
- 15 except provisions that conflict with this subchapter or Section
- 16 <u>13.009</u>.
- SECTION 5. Section 20.062(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (b) The department shall prescribe and use a change of
- 20 address form and procedure that combines department and voter
- 21 registration functions. The form must allow a licensee or
- 22 cardholder to indicate that [whether] the change of address is not
- 23 [also to be used] for voter registration purposes.
- SECTION 6. Section 20.063, Election Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- Sec. 20.063. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES. (a) The Department
- 27 of Public Safety shall consider an application made in person, by

- 1 $\underline{\text{mail, or online at the department's Internet website}}$ [$\underline{\text{provide to}}$
- 2 each person who applies in person at the department's offices] for
- 3 an original or renewal of a driver's license, a personal
- 4 identification card, or a duplicate or corrected license or card by
- 5 <u>a person who is eligible to vote as provided by Section 13.001 an</u>
- 6 <u>application for</u> [opportunity to complete a] voter registration.
- 7 The date of application is considered to be the date of submission
- 8 to the voter registrar for the purpose of determining the effective
- 9 date of registration [application form].
- 10 (b) The Department of Public Safety shall consider a change
- 11 of address that relates to [When the department processes] a
- 12 license or card and that is submitted to [for renewal by mail,] the
- 13 department [shall deliver to the applicant by mail a voter
- 14 registration application form.
- 15 [(c) A change of address that relates to a license or card
- 16 $\frac{\text{and that is submitted to the department}}{\text{or}}$ in person_. [or] by mail.
- 17 online at the department's Internet website [serves] as a change in
- 18 [of address for] voter registration [unless the licensee or
- 19 cardholder indicates that the change is not for voter registration
- 20 purposes]. The date of submission of a change of address to a
- 21 department employee is considered to be the date of submission to
- 22 the voter registrar for the purpose of determining the effective
- 23 date of registration [only].
- (c) The registration of an eligible [(d) If a completed]
- 25 voter <u>as required by Subsections (a) and (b) is automatic unless the</u>
- 26 person indicates that the transaction is not for voter
- 27 registration <u>purposes</u> [application submitted to a department

- 1 employee does not include the applicant's correct driver's license
- 2 number or personal identification card number, a department
- 3 employee shall enter the appropriate information on the
- 4 application. If a completed application does not include the
- 5 applicant's correct residence address or mailing address, a
- 6 department employee shall obtain the appropriate information from
- 7 the applicant and enter the information on the application].
- 8 SECTION 7. Section 20.065(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (b) Each weekday the department is regularly open for
- 11 business, the department shall electronically transfer to the
- 12 secretary of state the name and information designated by the
- 13 secretary of state for [of each person who completes a] voter
- 14 registration for each individual who is eligible to vote as
- 15 provided by Section 13.001 and applies in person, by mail, or online
- 16 <u>at the department's Internet website for an original or renewal of a</u>
- 17 driver's license, a personal identification card, or a duplicate or
- 18 corrected license or card [application submitted to the
- 19 department]. The secretary shall prescribe procedures necessary to
- 20 implement this subsection.
- 21 SECTION 8. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Section 411.1795 to read as follows:
- 23 <u>Sec. 411.1795. DESIGNATION ON DRIVER'S LICENSE, COMMERCIAL</u>
- 24 DRIVER'S LICENSE, OR PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE. The
- 25 department shall adopt rules allowing an applicant for an original,
- 26 <u>duplicate</u>, modified, or renewed license under this subchapter, in
- 27 addition to being issued an original, duplicate, modified, or

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- 1 renewed license, to elect to include on the person's driver's
- 2 license, commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 3 certificate a designation indicating that the person is licensed
- 4 under this subchapter. The rules must include procedures to ensure
- 5 that a person who makes an election under this section:
- 6 (1) receives a designation on the person's driver's
- 7 <u>license</u>, commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 8 certificate only if the person meets the requirements for issuance
- 9 of the original, duplicate, modified, or renewed handgun license;
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (2) maintains the designation only during the period
- 12 for which the person is licensed to carry a handgun under this
- 13 subchapter.
- 14 SECTION 9. Section 411.205, Government Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- Sec. 411.205. REQUIREMENT TO DISPLAY LICENSE. If a license
- 17 holder is carrying a handgun on or about the license holder's person
- 18 when a magistrate or a peace officer demands that the license holder
- 19 display identification, the license holder shall display either:
- 20 (1) the license holder's:
- (A) driver's license or commercial driver's
- 22 <u>license that includes a handgun license designation under Section</u>
- 23 <u>521.128 or 522.0302</u>, Transportation Code; or
- 24 (B) personal identification certificate that
- 25 <u>includes a designation under Section 521.105, Transportation Code;</u>
- 26 or
- 27 (2) both the license holder's driver's license,

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- 1 commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 2 certificate issued by the department and the license holder's
- 3 handgun license.
- 4 SECTION 10. Section 521.011, Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 521.011. SERVICES INFORMATION FOR VETERANS. The
- 7 department and the Texas Veterans Commission shall jointly develop
- 8 a one-page informational paper about veterans services provided by
- 9 this state for veterans who receive:
- 10 (1) a driver's license with a designation under
- 11 Section 521.1235; [or]
- 12 (2) a commercial driver's license with a designation
- 13 under Section 522.0301; or
- 14 (3) a personal identification certificate with a
- 15 designation under Section 521.102.
- SECTION 11. Section 521.101(1), Transportation Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (1) The application for the personal identification
- 19 certificate must provide space for the applicant:
- 20 (1) to voluntarily list any information that may
- 21 qualify the applicant to receive a personal identification
- 22 certificate with a designation under Section 521.102 or 521.106;
- 23 and
- 24 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 25 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- SECTION 12. Subchapter E, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 27 is amended by adding Sections 521.105 and 521.106 to read as

1 follows:

- 2 Sec. 521.105. HANDGUN LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to available funds, the department shall include on each personal 3 identification certificate issued to a person licensed to carry a 4 handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, who makes 5 an election under Section 411.1795, Government Code, a designation 6 7 that shows the person is licensed under that subchapter. The 8 designation must include the person's handgun license number and a statement of the period for which the handgun license is effective. 9 10 Sec. 521.106. LIFETIME RESIDENT HUNTING, FISHING, OR COMBINATION HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to 11 available funds, the department shall include on a personal 12 identification certificate issued to a person who holds a lifetime 13 resident hunting, fishing, or combination hunting and fishing 14 15 license issued under Section 42.0021, 46.004(d), or 50.001(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, as applicable, a designation that shows 16 17 the person's status as a holder of the applicable license if the 18 person:
- 19 <u>(1) requests the designation; and</u>
- 20 (2) provides proof sufficient to the department that
- 21 the person is a holder of the applicable license.
- SECTION 13. Subchapter F, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 23 is amended by adding Sections 521.128 and 521.129 to read as
- 24 follows:
- Sec. 521.128. HANDGUN LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to
- 26 available funds, the department shall include on each driver's
- 27 license issued to a person licensed to carry a handgun under

- 1 Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, who makes an election
- 2 under Section 411.1795, Government Code, a designation that shows
- 3 the person is licensed under that subchapter. The designation must
- 4 include the person's handgun license number and a statement of the
- 5 period for which the handgun license is effective.
- 6 Sec. 521.129. LIFETIME RESIDENT HUNTING, FISHING, OR
- 7 COMBINATION HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to
- 8 available funds, the department shall include on a driver's license
- 9 issued to a person who holds a lifetime resident hunting, fishing,
- 10 or combination hunting and fishing license issued under Section
- 11 <u>42.0021</u>, <u>46.004(d)</u>, or <u>50.001(b)</u>, Parks and Wildlife Code, as
- 12 applicable, a designation that shows the person's status as a
- 13 holder of the applicable license if the person:
- 14 (1) requests the designation; and
- 15 (2) provides proof sufficient to the department that
- 16 the person is a holder of the applicable license.
- 17 SECTION 14. Section 521.142(i), Transportation Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (i) The application must provide space for the applicant:
- 20 (1) to voluntarily list any information that may
- 21 qualify the applicant to receive a license with a designation under
- 22 Section 521.1235 or 521.129; and
- 23 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 24 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 25 SECTION 15. Section 522.021, Transportation Code, is
- 26 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 27 (f) The application must provide space for the applicant:

- 1 (1) to voluntarily list any information that may
- 2 qualify the applicant to receive a license with a designation under
- 3 Section 522.0301 or 522.0303; and
- 4 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 5 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 6 SECTION 16. Subchapter C, Chapter 522, Transportation Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Sections 522.0301, 522.0302, and 522.0303 to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 522.0301. DESIGNATION ON COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE
- 10 ISSUED TO VETERAN. (a) <u>In this section:</u>
- 11 (1) "Disability rating" has the meaning assigned by
- 12 Section 11.22, Tax Code.
- 13 (2) "Disabled veteran" and "veteran" have the meanings
- 14 assigned by Section 521.1235.
- 15 (b) The department shall include the designation "VETERAN"
- on a commercial driver's license issued to a veteran in an available
- 17 space on the face of the commercial driver's license or on the
- 18 reverse side of the commercial driver's license if:
- 19 (1) the veteran requests the designation; and
- 20 (2) the veteran provides proof sufficient to the
- 21 department of the veteran's military service and honorable
- 22 <u>discharge.</u>
- 23 (c) If a disabled veteran provides proof sufficient to the
- 24 department, the department, on request of the disabled veteran,
- 25 shall include on a commercial driver's license issued to the
- 26 disabled veteran in any available space on the face of the
- 27 commercial driver's license or on the reverse side of the

- 1 commercial driver's license:
- 2 <u>(1) a disabled veteran designation; and</u>
- 3 (2) the branch of the service in which the disabled
- 4 <u>veteran served</u>.
- 5 (d) The department shall provide to the recipient of a
- 6 commercial driver's license with a designation under this section
- 7 the informational paper described by Section 521.011 at the time
- 8 the license is issued.
- 9 (e) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by
- 10 Subsection (f), for purposes of obtaining a service or benefit
- 11 available for disabled veterans in this state, a disabled veteran
- 12 may use a commercial driver's license described by Subsection (c)
- 13 as satisfactory proof:
- 14 (1) that the disabled veteran has a disability rating
- described by Section 521.1235(a)(2)(A) or (B), as applicable; and
- 16 (2) of branch of service and honorable discharge.
- 17 <u>(f) A commercial driver's license described by Subsection</u>
- 18 (c) is not satisfactory proof of the disabled veteran's disability
- 19 rating for purposes of obtaining a property tax exemption provided
- 20 by Chapter 11, Tax Code.
- 21 (g) A disabled veteran who renews a commercial driver's
- 22 license described by Subsection (c) shall provide proof sufficient
- 23 to the department of the disabled veteran's disability rating.
- Sec. 522.0302. HANDGUN LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to
- 25 available funds, the department shall include on each commercial
- 26 driver's license issued to a person licensed to carry a handgun
- 27 under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, who makes an

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- 1 election under Section 411.1795, Government Code, a designation
- 2 that shows the person is licensed under that subchapter. The
- 3 designation must include the person's handgun license number and a
- 4 statement of the period for which the handgun license is effective.
- 5 Sec. 522.0303. LIFETIME RESIDENT HUNTING, FISHING, OR
- 6 COMBINATION HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSE DESIGNATION. Subject to
- 7 available funds, the department shall include on a commercial
- 8 driver's license issued to a person who holds a lifetime resident
- 9 hunting, fishing, or combination hunting and fishing license issued
- 10 under Section 42.0021, 46.004(d), or 50.001(b), Parks and Wildlife
- 11 Code, as applicable, a designation that shows the person's status
- 12 as a holder of the applicable license if the person:
- 13 (1) requests the designation; and
- 14 (2) provides proof sufficient to the department that
- 15 the person is a holder of the applicable license.
- SECTION 17. Not later than December 1, 2019, the Department
- 17 of Public Safety shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 18 411.1795, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 18. (a) Section 411.1795, Government Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, applies only to an applicant for an original,
- 21 duplicate, modified, or renewed license to carry a handgun under
- 22 Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, as amended by this Act,
- 23 who submits the application on or after January 1, 2020.
- (b) The changes in law made by this Act to Chapters 521 and
- 25 522, Transportation Code, apply only to a driver's license,
- 26 commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 27 certificate issued or renewed under Chapter 521 or 522,

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- 1 Transportation Code, on or after January 1, 2020.
- 2 SECTION 19. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
