## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the requirement that the State Board of Veterinary
- 3 Medical Examiners provide a copy of a complaint to the subject of
- 4 the complaint.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 801.207, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the board shall
- 9 provide a copy of each complaint to the license holder who is the
- 10 subject of the complaint not later than the 14th day after the date
- 11 the complaint is filed with the board, unless providing a copy of
- 12 the complaint would jeopardize an investigation. The board may not
- 13 require the license holder to request a copy of the complaint.
- SECTION 2. Section 801.207(b-1), Occupations Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, applies only to a complaint filed with the State Board
- 16 of Veterinary Medical Examiners on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. A complaint filed with the board before the effective date
- 18 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 19 complaint was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
