- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 92.026 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 92.026. NOTICE REGARDING ENTRY TO DWELLING BY
- 8 LANDLORD. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a landlord may
- 9 enter a dwelling only if the landlord has delivered to the tenant,
- 10 at least 48 hours before the entry, a written notice containing the
- 11 date and time the landlord will enter the tenant's dwelling and the
- 12 purpose for the entry.
- (b) After giving notice as required by Subsection (a), a
- 14 landlord may enter a dwelling only:
- 15 (1) on the date and at the time contained in the
- 16 notice; and
- 17 (2) for the purpose stated in the notice.
- (c) In the case of an emergency, a landlord may enter a
- 19 dwelling as necessary without providing the notice required by
- 20 Subsection (a).
- 21 (d) A provision of a lease that purports to waive a right or
- 22 to exempt a party from a liability or duty under this section is
- 23 void.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

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- 1 to a lease agreement entered into or renewed on or after the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
