5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 418.054 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 418.054. REPORT ON BUILDING TRADE SERVICES FOLLOWING
8	DISASTERS. (a) Not later than November 1, 2020, the division shall
9	submit a report to members of the legislature on improving the
10	oversight, accountability, and availability of building trade
11	services following disasters. The report must include:
12	(1) strategies to increase the availability of
13	tradespeople, including plumbers and electricians, following a
14	disaster;
15	(2) approaches to increase prosecutions of alleged
16	fraud related to building trade services offered following a
17	disaster; and
18	(3) methods to encourage performance bond
19	requirements in contracts for building trade services to be
20	performed following a disaster.
21	(b) The division shall consult with appropriate state
22	entities, including the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and
23	Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, local governments,
