## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a report on the quality of care provided to and quality

3 of life of assisted living facility residents.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "commission" means the

6 Health and Human Services Commission.

7 (b) The commission shall conduct a study of not less than 30

8 percent of assisted living facilities licensed under Chapter 247,

9 Health and Safety Code, to assess the quality of care provided to

- 8 percent of assisted living facilities licensed under Chapter 247,
  9 Health and Safety Code, to assess the quality of care provided to
  10 and quality of life of facility residents. The commission shall
  11 ensure that a broad range of facility types are included in the
  12 study.
- 13 (c) In conducting the study, the commission shall:
- (1) conduct on-site case reviews of the care provided to residents of the assisted living facilities included in the study;
- 17 (2) review the disclosure statements and policies, 18 including policies related to residents' rights, of the assisted 19 living facilities included in the study; and
- 20 (3) conduct interviews with:
- 21 (A) facility residents;
- 22 (B) as applicable, legally authorized
- 23 representatives of facility residents;
- (C) facility personnel; and

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- 1 (D) any ombudsman that investigates and reviews
- 2 the assisted living facilities included in the study.
- 3 (d) Not later than January 15, 2022, the commission shall
- 4 prepare and submit to the governor, the legislature, and the
- 5 executive commissioner of the commission a written report based on
- 6 the study conducted under this section that, at a minimum, includes
- 7 an analysis of:
- 8 (1) resident demographics and the chronic health
- 9 conditions of facility residents;
- 10 (2) the provision to residents of person-centered
- 11 care;
- 12 (3) resident medication management and the delegation
- 13 of responsibility to registered nurses;
- 14 (4) resident care coordination and service planning;
- 15 (5) the daily living activities of facility residents;
- 16 and
- 17 (6) facility personnel.
- 18 (e) This section expires September 1, 2023.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
