- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 611, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 611.0041 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 611.0041. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE OF CONFIDENTIAL
- 8 INFORMATION OTHER THAN IN JUDICIAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING.
- 9 (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Patient" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 11 552.0011.
- 12 (2) "State hospital" has the meaning assigned by
- 13 <u>Section 552.0011.</u>
- 14 (b) To the extent permitted by federal law, a professional
- 15 shall disclose confidential information to the descendant of a
- 16 patient of a state hospital if:
- 17 (1) the patient has been deceased for at least 50
- 18 years; and
- 19 (2) the professional does not have information
- 20 indicating that releasing the medical record is inconsistent with
- 21 any prior expressed preference of the deceased patient or personal
- 22 representatives of the deceased patient's estate.
- (c) A person who receives information from confidential
- 24 communications or records may not disclose the information except

- 1 to the extent that disclosure is consistent with the authorized
- 2 purposes for which the person first obtained the information.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
