- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1.15(b), Chapter 626, Acts of the 73rd
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 1993, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Sections 1.17, 1.21, and 1.33 of
- 8 this article, a person may not withdraw water from the aquifer or
- 9 begin construction of a well or other works designed for the
- 10 withdrawal of water from the aquifer without obtaining a permit
- 11 from the authority.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 626, Acts of the 73rd Legislature,
- 13 Regular Session, 1993, is amended by adding Section 1.21 to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 Sec. 1.21. SUBSTITUTE WITHDRAWALS. In addition to
- 16 permitted withdrawals from the aquifer, a municipally owned utility
- 17 owned by the City of San Antonio, without a permit, may withdraw
- 18 groundwater from the aquifer if:
- 19 (1) the utility uses the groundwater to supply a
- 20 military installation with water for human consumption,
- 21 irrigation, operations, mission support, or infrastructure
- 22 maintenance; and
- 23 (2) the utility and the military installation enter
- 24 into a contract requiring the installation to reduce its

- 1 groundwater withdrawals from the aquifer by the same amount of
- 2 withdrawn water the installation receives from the utility.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
