- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 87.042, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 87.042. COUNTY COMMISSIONER VACANCY. Not later than
- 8 the 30th day after the date [If] a vacancy occurs in the office of
- 9 county commissioner, the county judge shall appoint a suitable
- 10 resident of the precinct in which the vacancy exists to fill the
- 11 vacancy until the next general election.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 87.042, Local Government Code, as
- 13 amended by this Act, applies only to a vacancy in the office of
- 14 county commissioner that occurs on or after the effective date of
- 15 this Act. If a vacancy in the office of county commissioner
- 16 occurred and has not been filled before the effective date of this
- 17 Act, the county judge shall appoint, not later than the 30th day
- 18 after the effective date of this Act, a suitable resident of the
- 19 precinct in which the vacancy exists to fill the vacancy until the
- 20 next general election.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
