- (1) the enrollment in a high school equivalency

  13 program or a postsecondary ability to benefit program of at least 25

  14 percent of all students receiving adult education and literacy
- services from the entity during that program year; and

  (2) the achievement by the end of that program year of

  a high school equivalency certificate or a postsecondary

  certificate by at least 70 percent of those students receiving

  adult education and literacy services from the entity at the

  beginning of that program year who are enrolled in a high school

  equivalency program or a postsecondary ability to benefit program.
- 22 <u>(d) In this section, "postsecondary ability to benefit</u>
  23 <u>program" means a postsecondary certificate program in which a</u>
  24 person who does not have a high school diploma or equivalency

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- 1 certificate and who both qualifies for federal student financial
- 2 aid and demonstrates on an assessment instrument that the person
- 3 can pass college-level courses with some support may enroll.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
