## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting telemarketers from transmitting misleading
- 3 caller identification information or otherwise misrepresenting the
- 4 origin of a telemarketing call.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 304.151, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 8 read as follows:

- 9 (b) A telemarketer may not:
- 10 (1) interfere with or circumvent the capability of a
- 11 caller identification service or device to access or provide to the
- 12 recipient of the telemarketing call any information regarding the
- 13 call that the service or device is capable of providing; [or]
- 14 (2) fail to provide caller identification information
- in a manner that is accessible by a caller identification service or
- 16 device, if the telemarketer is capable of providing the information
- 17 in that manner; or
- 18 (3) cause misleading information to be transmitted to
- 19 a recipient's caller identification service or device or to
- 20 otherwise misrepresent the origin of a telemarketing call.
- (c) A telemarketer does not violate Subsection (b)(3) if the
- 22 <u>telemarketer</u> substitutes the name and telephone number of the
- 23 person on whose behalf the call is made for the telemarketer's name
- 24 <u>and telephone number.</u>
