- 7 Sec. 656.004. CONSIDERATION OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
- 8 INFORMATION. (a) In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Applicant" means a pers</u>on who has made an oral or
- 10 written application with an employer, or has sent a resume or other
- 11 correspondence to an employer, indicating an interest in
- 12 employment.

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- 13 (2) "Criminal history record information" has the
- 14 meaning assigned by Section 411.082.
- 15 (3) "State agency" means an agency in any branch of
- 16 <u>state government</u>.
- 17 (b) A state agency may not include a question regarding an
- 18 applicant's criminal history record information on an initial
- 19 <u>employment application form.</u>
- 20 <u>(c) A state agency may inquire into or consider an</u>
- 21 applicant's criminal history record information after the agency
- 22 has determined that the applicant is otherwise qualified and has
- 23 conditionally offered the applicant employment.
- 24 (d) This section does not apply to an applicant for a

- 1 position:
- 2 (1) that involves the provision of services to or care
- 3 <u>of children;</u>
- 4 (2) that requires direct interaction with children; or
- 5 (3) for which consideration of criminal history record
- 6 <u>information is otherwise required by law.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
