BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 7.003, Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 7.003. ENFORCEMENT REPORT AND STATUS MEETINGS. 8 9 SECTION 2. Section 7.003, Water Code, is amended by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows: 10 11 (d) The commission shall publish each report required under Subsection (a) on the commission's Internet website not later than 12 the 15th day before the date of a meeting of the commission for 13 which public notice is given. 14 (e) This subsection applies to an enforcement action for 15 16 which a decision or order of the commission has become final as provided by Section 2001.144, Government Code, and that involves a 17 violation of Chapter 361, Health and Safety Code, by or at a 18 municipal solid waste facility. On the request of a state senator 19 or state representative, the commission quarterly shall conduct in 20 the county in which the facility that is the subject of the 21 enforcement action is located a public informational meeting 22 23 regarding the status of the enforcement action. A representative of the facility that is the subject of the enforcement action must 24

1	attend a meeting held under this subsection and must make a
2	reasonable effort to respond to questions relevant to the
3	enforcement action at the meeting. The commission shall post
4	notice of the meeting on the commission's Internet website and
5	publish the notice once a week for two consecutive weeks before the
6	meeting in one or more newspapers having general circulation in the
7	county in which the meeting will be held. The notice must state the
8	time, location, and subject matter of the meeting. The owner of the
9	facility that is the subject of the enforcement action must
10	reimburse the commission for the cost of publishing notice under
11	this section.
12	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
