4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 29.153(a-1), (b), and (f), Education

- (a-1) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes if the district identifies 15 or more children who are [eligible under 9 Subsection (b) and are] at least four years of age. A school district may offer prekindergarten classes if the district identifies 15 or more [eligible] children who are eligible under Subsection (b)(1) [at least three years of age]. A district may not charge twition for a prekindergarten class offered under this
- 13 charge tuition for a prekindergarten class offered under this 14 section.
- 15 (b) A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten 16 class under this section if the child is:
- 17 <u>(1)</u> at least three years of age and:

- 11 (2) the numbers of half-day and full-day
- 12 prekindergarten classes offered by the district and campus;
- 13 (3) the sources of funding for the prekindergarten
- 14 classes;
- 15 (4) the class size and ratio of instructional staff to
- 16 students for each prekindergarten program class offered by the
- 17 district and campus;
- 18 (5) if the district elects to administer an assessment
- 19 instrument to students enrolled in district and campus
- 20 prekindergarten program classes, a description and the results of
- 21 each type of assessment instrument; and
- 22 (6) curricula used in the district's prekindergarten
- 23 program classes.
- SECTION 3. Section 29.166(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- 26 (c) A student qualifies for additional funding under
- 27 Subsection (b) if the student[+

- 1 [(1) satisfies eligibility requirements under Section
- 2 <del>29.153(b); and</del>
- 3  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  is four years of age on September 1 of the year
- 4 the student begins the program.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 29.153(d), Education Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect August 1, 2023.
