- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 481.075, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsections (n), (o), and (p) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(n) A person dispensing a Schedule II controlled substance</u>
- 9 under a prescription shall provide written notice, as defined by
- 10 board rule adopted under Subsection (o), on the safe disposal of
- 11 controlled substance prescription drugs, unless:
- 12 (1) the Schedule II controlled substance prescription
- 13 drug is dispensed at a pharmacy or other location that:
- 14 (A) is authorized to take back those drugs for
- 15 safe disposal; and
- 16 (B) regularly accepts those drugs for safe
- 17 disposal; or
- 18 (2) the dispenser provides to the person to whom the
- 19 Schedule II controlled substance prescription drug is dispensed, at
- 20 the time of dispensation and at no cost to the person:
- 21 (A) a mail-in pouch for surrendering unused
- 22 controlled substance prescription drugs; or
- 23 (B) chemicals to render any unused drugs unusable
- 24 or non-retrievable.

- (o) The board shall adopt rules to prescribe the form of the 1 2 written notice on the safe disposal of controlled substance prescription drugs required under Subsection (n). The notice must 3 include information on locations at which Schedule II controlled 4 substance prescription drugs are accepted for safe disposal. The 5 6 notice, in lieu of listing those locations, may provide the address of an Internet website specified by the board that provides a 7 searchable database of locations at which Schedule II controlled 8 substance prescription drugs are accepted for safe disposal. 9
- 10 (p) The board may take disciplinary action against a person
 11 who fails to comply with Subsection (n).
- SECTION 2. Section 481.075(n), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a controlled substance prescription drug dispensed on or after January 1, 2020.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
