5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.911 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.911. BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL. (a) In this
8	section, "behavioral health professional" means:
9	(1) a licensed specialist in school psychology
10	licensed under Chapter 501, Occupations Code;
11	(2) a licensed professional counselor licensed under
12	Chapter 503, Occupations Code;
13	(3) a licensed clinical social worker licensed under
14	Chapter 505, Occupations Code; or
15	(4) a school counselor with an appropriate certificate
16	or permit issued under Subchapter B, Chapter 21.
17	(b) A school district that receives additional state aid
18	under Section 42.25185 shall:

- 8 Sec. 37.0016. REFERRAL TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES. (a)
- 9 If an educator notifies the campus behavior coordinator designated
- 10 under Section 37.0012 about a concern regarding the behavioral
- 11 health of a student enrolled at the campus, the campus behavior
- 12 coordinator shall consult with the student's parent or guardian and
- 13 if appropriate make a referral of opportunities for the student to
- 14 access behavioral health services.
- 15 (b) A referral made under Subsection (a) must include
- 16 behavioral health services from a behavioral health professional,
- 17 as defined by Section 33.911, who provides services at the campus in
- 18 a manner provided by that section.
- 19 (c) If the services of a behavioral health professional are
- 20 not provided at the campus in the manner described by Section
- 21 33.911, a referral made under Subsection (a) may include a referral
- 22 <u>for behavioral health services from a local mental health authority</u>
- 23 or a private or community-based provider of behavioral health
- 24 services.
- 25 (d) If Subsection (c) applies and during the consultation
- 26 under Subsection (a), the student's parent or guardian informs the
- 27 campus behavior coordinator that the parent or guardian is not able

- 1 to pay for behavioral health services and that the student is not
- 2 covered under a health insurance policy or other health benefit
- 3 plan, the campus behavior coordinator, with the consent of the
- 4 parent or guardian, shall coordinate with available
- 5 community-based organizations, faith-based organizations, or other
- 6 appropriate providers to secure behavioral health services for the
- 7 student.
- 8 (e) The campus behavior coordinator shall annually report
- 9 to the campus principal the number of students for which a referral
- 10 for behavioral health services is made under this section. The
- 11 report must include, for each student for whom a referral is made,
- 12 the student's:
- 13 <u>(1) disability status;</u>
- 14 (2) race; and
- 15 <u>(3) sex.</u>
- SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 42.25185 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 42.25185. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
- 19 PROFESSIONALS. (a) For each school year, the commissioner may
- 20 provide additional state aid to each school district in an amount,
- 21 <u>as determined by the commissioner, sufficient to assist the</u>
- 22 district in employing or contracting for the services of behavioral
- 23 health professionals under Section 33.911, if funds are available
- 24 for that purpose.
- 25 (b) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 26 administer this section.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2020-2021

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- 1 school year.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
