5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 8, Occupations Code, is amended by adding
7	Chapter 1306 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 1306. REROOFING CONTRACTORS
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 1306.001. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as
11	the Reroofing Contractor Registration Act.
12	Sec. 1306.002. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
13	(1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission of
14	Licensing and Regulation.
15	(2) "Department" means the Texas Department of
16	Licensing and Regulation.
17	(3) "Executive director" means the executive director
18	of the department.
19	(4) "Person" means an individual or business entity.
20	(5) "Registered reroofing contractor" means a
21	reroofing contractor who is registered under this chapter and who
22	holds a statement of registration number issued under this chapter.
23	(6) "Reroofing contractor" means a person who:
24	(A) engages in repairing, recovering, or

- 1 replacing existing roof coverings on residential or commercial
- 2 structures; or
- 3 (B) solicits, advertises, or contracts to
- 4 repair, recover, or replace existing roof coverings on residential
- 5 or commercial structures.
- 6 (7) "Reroofing project" means a project to repair,
- 7 recover, or replace an existing roof covering on a residential or
- 8 commercial structure.
- 9 Sec. 1306.003. EXEMPTIONS. (a) This chapter does not apply
- 10 <u>to:</u>
- 11 (1) an owner of residential property or property
- 12 primarily used for agricultural purposes, or an employee of the
- 13 owner, who performs a reroofing project on the owner's property;
- 14 (2) an authorized employee or representative of the
- 15 United States government, this state, or a county, municipality, or
- 16 other political subdivision of this state acting in an official
- 17 capacity;
- 18 <u>(3) the new construction of a residential</u> or
- 19 commercial structure;
- 20 (4) a person performing a minor reroofing project the
- 21 value of which does not exceed \$500;
- 22 (5) a person who is licensed as a retailer of
- 23 manufactured homes under Chapter 1201 and is performing a reroofing
- 24 project on a manufactured home as defined by Section 1201.003;
- 25 (6) subject to Subsection (b), an individual who is a
- 26 sales manager, project manager, or other individual employed or
- 27 otherwise engaged by a registered reroofing contractor in the

- 1 ordinary course of the contractor's business if the individual does
- 2 not otherwise engage in repairing, recovering, or replacing
- 3 existing roof coverings on residential or commercial structures; or
- 4 (7) an individual who otherwise engages in repairing,
- 5 recovering, or replacing existing roof coverings on residential or
- 6 commercial structures as an employee of or under contract with a
- 7 registered reroofing contractor if the individual is not involved
- 8 in soliciting, advertising, or executing contracts for the
- 9 contractor.
- 10 (b) An individual described by Subsection (a)(6) shall
- 11 operate in the name of the registered reroofing contractor and the
- 12 contractor is responsible for the conduct of that individual in
- 13 complying with the requirements of this chapter.
- 14 Sec. 1306.004. APPLICATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter does
- 15 <u>not authorize a registered reroofing contractor to engage in:</u>
- 16 (1) the practice of engineering as defined by Section
- 17 1001.003; or
- 18 (2) the practice of architecture as defined by Section
- 19 1051.001.
- 20 <u>SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES</u>
- Sec. 1306.051. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The department
- 22 shall administer and enforce this chapter.
- Sec. 1306.052. RULES. (a) The commission by rule shall:
- 24 (1) prescribe the requirements for the issuance and
- 25 renewal of a registration under this chapter; and
- 26 (2) with respect to reroofing projects on property
- 27 located in an area for which the governor declares a state of

- 1 disaster under Chapter 418, Government Code, provide for the
- 2 issuance of a temporary emergency registration at a reduced fee.
- 3 (b) The commission may adopt additional rules as necessary
- 4 to administer this chapter.
- 5 Sec. 1306.053. FEES. (a) Except as provided by Subsection
- 6 (b), the commission shall establish and collect reasonable and
- 7 necessary fees in amounts sufficient to cover the costs of
- 8 administering this chapter.
- 9 (b) The fees adopted under this chapter must include fees
- 10 <u>for:</u>
- 11 (1) an initial application for registration, in an
- 12 amount not to exceed \$250; and
- 13 (2) the renewal of a registration, in an amount not to
- 14 exceed \$100.
- 15 Sec. 1306.054. REGISTRATION DATABASE. The department shall
- 16 make available on its Internet website a publicly accessible list
- 17 of all registered reroofing contractors who are in good standing.
- 18 The list must be searchable by name and location. The list must
- 19 contain the following for each registered reroofing contractor:
- 20 (1) the name, mailing address, and telephone number of
- 21 the reroofing contractor;
- 22 (2) a summary of any disciplinary action taken by the
- 23 department against the reroofing contractor; and
- 24 (3) any other information required by the department.
- Sec. 1306.055. REGISTRATION VERIFICATION. (a) A county or
- 26 municipal building official may not grant or approve a building or
- 27 construction permit for a reroofing project unless the applicant

1 for the permit is: 2 (1) a registered reroofing contractor; or 3 (2) exempt from registration under this chapter. 4 (b) On request of a county or municipal building official, the department shall verify the registration of an applicant 5 described by Subsection (a). The department shall establish a 6 7 verification system to ensure a timely response to a request for verification of a registration. 8 9 SUBCHAPTER C. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS 10 Sec. 1306.101. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) Unless the person holds a registration issued under this chapter, a person may 11 12 not: 13 (1) perform or otherwise engage in a reroofing 14 project; or 15 (2) solicit, advertise, or contract to perform or engage in a reroofing project. 16 17 (b) A registration under this chapter shall be issued in the form of a statement of registration number. 18 19 (c) A registration issued under this chapter: 20 (1) is valid only with respect to the person named on the registration; and 21 22 (2) authorizes the registration holder to operate as a 23 reroofing contractor. 24 (d) A person may obtain a registration for more than one business entity. A registration is not transferable. 25 26 Sec. 1306.102. APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION. (a)

applicant for registration shall submit an application to the

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- 1 department on a form prescribed by the executive director.
- 2 (b) The application must be accompanied by:
- 3 (1) if the applicant is an individual, proof of the
- 4 applicant's identity;
- 5 (2) if the applicant is a business entity, proof of the
- 6 applicant's existence and confirmation of authority to conduct
- 7 business in this state under a certificate of status issued by the
- 8 secretary of state that is in good standing;
- 9 (3) proof of the mailing address and telephone number
- 10 of the applicant's residence or business location; and
- 11 (4) the application fee.
- 12 Sec. 1306.103. ISSUANCE OF REGISTRATION; TERM. (a) The
- 13 department shall issue a registration to an applicant who complies
- 14 with the registration requirements of this chapter not later than
- 15 the 10th day after the date the department receives the
- 16 application.
- 17 (b) A registration is valid for two years from the date of
- 18 issuance and may be renewed before expiration in the manner
- 19 provided by Section 1306.104.
- Sec. 1306.104. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. (a) To renew a
- 21 registration, a reroofing contractor shall submit an application
- 22 for renewal to the department on a form prescribed by the executive
- 23 <u>director</u>.
- 24 (b) The application must be accompanied by:
- 25 <u>(1) documentation of any changes in the reroofing</u>
- 26 contractor's information submitted to the department under Section
- 27 1306.102(b); and

1	(2) the renewal fee.
2	SUBCHAPTER D. PRACTICE BY REGISTRATION HOLDER
3	Sec. 1306.151. DISCLOSURE OF REGISTRATION NUMBER. (a) A
4	registered reroofing contractor shall include the contractor's
5	registration number in each:
6	(1) contract for a reroofing project in the manner
7	provided by Section 1306.153; and
8	(2) advertisement for a reroofing service by the
9	contractor, including on each business card, flyer, or door card
10	and in each television, radio, social media, or newspaper
11	advertisement.
12	(b) Other than the inclusion of a registration number in the
13	manner prescribed by this section, a reroofing contractor may not
14	make any representation or statement regarding the effect of being
15	issued a registration under this chapter or the fact that the
16	contractor has been issued a registration under this chapter.
17	Sec. 1306.152. CERTAIN PRACTICES RELATING TO INSURANCE
18	DEDUCTIBLES PROHIBITED. A registered reroofing contractor may not
19	advertise or promise to pay or rebate all or part of an insurance
20	deductible in connection with a reroofing project in violation of
21	Section 27.02, Business & Commerce Code.
22	Sec. 1306.153. CONTRACT FOR REROOFING PROJECT. (a) Before
23	engaging in a reroofing project, a registered reroofing contractor
24	must provide a written contract to the property owner that is signed
25	by the reroofing contractor and the property owner.
26	(b) A written contract under Subsection (a) must include:
27	(1) the following statement printed in at least

- 1 12-point bold type: "The work to be performed under this contract
- 2 must commence not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 3 reroofing contractor collects an initial payment, unless a longer
- 4 period is agreed to in writing and signed by both parties to this
- 5 contract.";
- 6 (2) the reroofing contractor's contact information,
- 7 <u>including physical address, e-mail address, and telephone number;</u>
- 8 (3) the reroofing contractor's policy regarding
- 9 cancellation of the contract, which must be consistent with state
- 10 <u>law;</u>
- 11 (4) the reroofing contractor's registration number in
- 12 at least 12-point bold type in the following form: "Texas
- 13 Registered Reroofing Contractor Number (registration number)"; and
- 14 <u>(5) the department's contact information for the</u>
- 15 purpose of directing complaints to the department.
- Sec. 1306.154. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAW. (a) A registered
- 17 reroofing contractor shall comply with each applicable:
- 18 (1) building code adopted by this state or a political
- 19 subdivision of this state; and
- 20 <u>(2) order, ordinance, or rule of a political</u>
- 21 subdivision relating to the issuance of a permit for or the
- 22 performance of a reroofing project in the political subdivision.
- 23 (b) A registered reroofing contractor shall comply with
- 24 Chapter 58, Business & Commerce Code, during a natural disaster, as
- 25 that term is defined by Section 58.001, Business & Commerce Code.
- SUBCHAPTER E. ENFORCEMENT
- Sec. 1306.201. INVESTIGATION OF COMPLAINTS. (a) The

- 1 department shall investigate any complaint alleging a violation of
- 2 this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter.
- 3 (b) A complaint must be filed in a manner prescribed by the
- 4 department.
- 5 Sec. 1306.202. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. The commission or
- 6 executive director may impose an administrative penalty on a person
- 7 under Subchapter F, Chapter 51, regardless of whether the person is
- 8 registered under this chapter, if the person violates:
- 9 <u>(1) this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter;</u>
- 10 <u>or</u>
- 11 (2) an order of the commission or executive director.
- 12 Sec. 1306.203. SANCTIONS. The commission may impose
- 13 sanctions as provided by Section 51.353.
- 14 Sec. 1306.204. CEASE AND DESIST ORDER. The executive
- 15 director may issue a cease and desist order under Section 51.3513 to
- 16 prohibit any person from performing or engaging in a reroofing
- 17 project if the person is not in compliance with this chapter.
- 18 Sec. 1306.205. CIVIL PENALTY. The attorney general or
- 19 executive director may institute an action for a civil penalty
- 20 under this chapter as provided by Section 51.352. The amount of a
- 21 civil penalty assessed under this section may not exceed \$500 for
- 22 each violation.
- 23 Sec. 1306.206. DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE. A reroofing
- 24 contractor who advertises that the contractor holds a registration
- 25 under this chapter commits a false, misleading, or deceptive act or
- 26 practice within the meaning of Section 17.46, Business & Commerce
- 27 Code, if the reroofing contractor does not hold a valid

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- 1 registration issued under this chapter.
- 2 SECTION 2. Not later than April 1, 2020, the Texas
- 3 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules,
- 4 procedures, and fees necessary to administer Chapter 1306,
- 5 Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation
- 7 is not required to begin issuing registrations under Chapter 1306,
- 8 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, before June 1, 2020.
- 9 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 10 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
- 11 (b) Section 1306.101, Occupations Code, and Subchapter E,
- 12 Chapter 1306, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, take effect
- 13 August 1, 2020.
