7	Sec. 1101.014. LIMITATION ON PROCEEDS DUE TO TERRORISTIC
8	ACT. Notwithstanding any other law, a life insurance policy may
9	provide that proceeds are limited to the amount paid in premiums if:
10	(1) the insured's death occurs as a result of the
11	insured's conduct constituting an offense involving violence to any
12	person or property and with the intent to:
13	(A) place the public or a substantial group of
14	the public in fear of serious bodily injury;
15	(B) influence the conduct or activities of a
16	branch or agency of the federal government, this state, or a
17	political subdivision of this state; or
18	(C) significantly disrupt or interfere with
19	lawful commerce or the right of lawful assembly; and
20	(2) the conduct described by Subdivision (1) occurred
21	not later than the second anniversary of the effective date of the
22	policy.
23	SECTION 2. Section 1101.014, Insurance Code, as added by

this Act, applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for
