adding Subsection (e-2) to read as follows:

9 (e-2) This subsection applies only to a reinvestment zone created by a municipality that has a population of 1.1 million or 10 more and is predominantly located in a county that has a population 11 12 of 1.8 million or less. Notwithstanding Subsection (e), if the municipality adopts an ordinance designating a termination date for 13 14 the zone that is later than the termination date designated in the ordinance creating the zone, the number of years for which the total 15 16 dollar amount may be deducted under Subsection (d)(4) is limited to the duration of the zone as determined under Section 311.017, Tax 17 Code. 18
