- SECTION 1. Section 36.066, Water Code, is amended by amending Subsection (g) and adding Subsection (i) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (g) If the district prevails in any suit other than a suit in
- 9 which it voluntarily intervenes, the district may seek and the
- 10 court may [shall] grant, in the interests of justice and as provided
- 11 by Subsection (h), in the same action, recovery for attorney's
- 12 fees, costs for expert witnesses, and other costs incurred by the
- 13 district before the court. The amount of the attorney's fees shall
- 14 be fixed by the court in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.
- 15 (i) Notwithstanding Section 36.052(a), Subsections (g) and
- 16 (h) of this section prevail over any other special law inconsistent
- 17 with those subsections unless the other law:
- 18 <u>(1) limits an award of attorney's fees in a suit to an</u>
- 19 amount less than \$100,000; or
- 20 (2) prohibits an award of attorney's fees or costs.
- 21 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a suit involving a groundwater conservation district that is filed
- 23 on or after the effective date of this Act. A suit filed before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is subject to the law in effect on the

- 1 date the suit is filed, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
