- 14 or LNG containers for use in this state;
- 15 (2) systems work that includes the [sale,]
- 16 installation, modification, or servicing of CNG or LNG systems for
- 17 use in this state, including the installation, modification, or
- 18 servicing by any person, except a political subdivision, of a CNG or
- 19 LNG motor fuel system or mobile fuel system on a vehicle used in the
- 20 transportation of the general public; or
- 21 (3) product work that includes the sale, storage,
- 22 transportation for delivery, or dispensing of CNG or LNG in this
- 23 state.
- (e) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the

- 1 registration of persons engaged in the manufacture of CNG cylinders
- 2 <u>or LNG containers for use in this state.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
