 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the licensure and registration of persons engaged in
 1-24 certain activities pertaining to compressed natural gas or
 1-25 liquefied natural gas containers and systems.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 116.031, Natural Resources Code, is
 1-28 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
 1-29 read as follows:

1-30 (a) Unless otherwise provided in this chapter or by
 1-31 commission rule, a person shall be required to obtain a license from
 1-32 the commission to engage in any of the following activities:

1-33 (1) work that includes the ~~manufacture,~~ assembly,
 1-34 repair, testing, sale, installation, or subframing of CNG cylinders
 1-35 or LNG containers for use in this state;

1-36 (2) systems work that includes the ~~sale,~~
 1-37 installation, modification, or servicing of CNG or LNG systems for
 1-38 use in this state, including the installation, modification, or
 1-39 servicing by any person, except a political subdivision, of a CNG or
 1-40 LNG motor fuel system or mobile fuel system on a vehicle used in the
 1-41 transportation of the general public; or

1-42 (3) product work that includes the sale, storage,
 1-43 transportation for delivery, or dispensing of CNG or LNG in this
 1-44 state.

1-45 (e) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the
 1-46 registration of persons engaged in the manufacture of CNG cylinders
 1-47 or LNG containers for use in this state.

1-48 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
