4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 241.051(d), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(d) <u>Information</u> [All information and materials] obtained or
8	compiled by the <u>commission</u> [department] in connection with a
9	complaint or [and] investigation that is [concerning a hospital
10	are] confidential by law, such as individually identifiable
11	information concerning a patient or health care professional, is
12	[and] not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552 [Section 552.001
13	et seq.], Government Code[, and not subject to disclosure,
14	discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal compulsion for their
15	release to anyone other than the department or its employees or
16	agents involved in the enforcement action except that this
17	information may be disclosed to:
18	[(1) persons involved with the department in the
19	enforcement action against the hospital;
20	[(2) the hospital that is the subject of the
21	enforcement action, or the hospital's authorized representative;
22	[(3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are
23	authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate hospital services;
24	[(4) law enforcement agencies; and

[(5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all 1 individual-identifying and hospital-identifying information has 2 been deleted]. 3 4 SECTION 2. Section 577.013(d), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: (d) Information [All information and materials] obtained or 6 compiled by the commission [department] in connection with a 7 complaint or [and] investigation that is [concerning a mental 8 hospital licensed under this chapter are] confidential by law, such as individually identifiable information concerning a patient or 10 health care professional, is [and] not subject to disclosure under 11 Chapter 552, Government Code [, discovery, subpoena, or other means 12 of legal compulsion for their release to anyone other than the 13 department or its employees or agents involved in the enforcement 14 15 action except that this information may be disclosed to: 16 [(1) persons involved with the department in the enforcement action against the licensed mental hospital; 17 [(2) the licensed mental hospital that is the subject 18 of the enforcement action, or the licensed mental hospital's 19 authorized representative; 20 (3) appropriate state or federal agencies that are 21 22 authorized to inspect, survey, or investigate licensed mental hospital services; 23 24 [(4) law enforcement agencies; and 25 (5) persons engaged in bona fide research, if all individual-identifying information and information identifying the 26 licensed mental hospital has been deleted]. 27

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- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 241.051(e) and 577.013(e), Health and
- 2 Safety Code, are repealed.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
