- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 109, Alcoholic Beverage
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 109.65 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 109.65. CERTAIN RETAIL SALES BELOW COST PROHIBITED.
- 9 (a) In this section, "retailer's cost" includes applicable
- 10 freight, taxes, and duties.
- 11 (b) A person who holds a permit or license authorizing the
- 12 retail sale of any alcoholic beverage for off-premise consumption
- 13 may not sell an alcoholic beverage at retail for off-premise
- 14 consumption at a cost less than the retailer's cost.
- 15 (c) Proof of the retailer's cost for alcoholic beverages
- 16 shall:
- 17 (1) become a part of the permanent records of each
- 18 person who holds a permit or license authorizing the retail sale of
- 19 any alcoholic beverage for off-premise consumption; and
- 20 (2) be available for a period of two years for
- 21 inspection by the commission.
- 22 (d) This section does not apply to the sale of a specific
- 23 alcoholic beverage product if the manufacturer of the product has
- 24 discontinued the production, importation, special packaging, or

- 1 market availability of the product.
- 2 <u>(e) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this</u>
- 3 <u>section.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
