- 8 Sec. 39.0552. CERTAIN STUDENTS RECEIVING RESIDENTIAL
- 9 SERVICES IN STATE HOSPITALS NOT CONSIDERED FOR ACCOUNTABILITY
- 10 PURPOSES. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, in
- 11 determining the performance of a school district or campus under
- 12 this chapter, a student receiving residential services in a state
- 13 hospital is not considered a student of the school district or
- 14 campus in which the state hospital is physically located.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
