1-22 relating to the consideration for public school accountability
 1-23 purposes of certain students receiving residential services in
 1-24 state hospitals.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
 1-27 amended by adding Section 39.0552 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 39.0552. CERTAIN STUDENTS RECEIVING RESIDENTIAL
 1-29 SERVICES IN STATE HOSPITALS NOT CONSIDERED FOR ACCOUNTABILITY
 1-30 PURPOSES. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, in
 1-31 determining the performance of a school district or campus under
 1-32 this chapter, a student receiving residential services in a state
 1-33 hospital is not considered a student of the school district or
 1-34 campus in which the state hospital is physically located.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
