A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-15 1-16 AN ACT

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relating to a report by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation concerning license applicants who are military service members, military veterans, or military spouses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 51, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 51.40135 to read as follows:

Sec. 51.40135. REPORT CONCERNING LICENSE APPLICANTS WHO ARE MILITARY SERVICE MEMBERS, MILITARY VETERANS, OR MILITARY SPOUSES. In this section, "military service member," "military an," and "military spouse" have the meanings assigned by (a) veteran," and 55.001.

The department shall review each type of license issued by the department to an individual to identify the types for which a significant number of military service members, military veterans,

or military spouses submit applications.

(c) Not later than December 1, 2020, the department shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each legislative standing committee with primary jurisdiction over the department a report on the results of the review and any recommendations related to the efficient issuance of licenses to qualified military service members, military veterans, and military spouses.

(d) The department shall make the report available on the

department's Internet website.

(e) This section expires September 1, 2021. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. SECTION 2.

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
