4	SECTION 1. Subtitle E, Title 10, Government Code, is

6	CHAPTER 2207. DISPLAY OF NATIONAL MOTTO IN GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS
7	Sec. 2207.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Political subdivision" includes a public school
9	<u>district.</u>
10	(2) "State agency" includes an institution of higher
11	education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.
12	Sec. 2207.002. DISPLAY OF NATIONAL MOTTO. (a) A building
13	owned by this state or a political subdivision of this state must
14	display a durable poster or framed copy of the United States
15	national motto, "In God We Trust," if the poster or framed copy
16	meets the requirements of Subsection (b) and is:
17	(1) donated for display in the building; or
18	(2) purchased from private donations and made
19	available for the building.
20	(b) A poster or framed copy of the national motto described
21	by Subsection (a) must contain a representation of the United
22	States flag centered under the national motto and a representation
23	of the state flag.
24	(c) A state agency and political subdivision may accept and

1 use private donations for the purposes of Subsection (a).

SECTION 2. Section 1.004, Education Code, is repealed.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
