9	measuring device [that is exclusively used to weigh food sold for
10	<pre>immediate consumption] is exempt from this subchapter, including</pre>
11	the inspection requirements under Section 13.101 and the
12	registration requirements under Section 13.1011, if the device is
13	exclusively used to weigh food:
14	(1) sold ready for immediate consumption, regardless
15	of whether the food is consumed on the premises where the food is
16	weighed and sold; and
17	(2) not exempted from sales and use taxes under
18	Section 151.314, Tax Code.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
