A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to preventing the loss of benefits by certain retirees of
- 3 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas who resume service.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 824.601(b-1), Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Subsection (b) does not apply to a retiree under
- 8 Section 824.202 whose effective date of retirement is on or before
- 9 August 31, 2018 [January 1, 2011].
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 824.602, Government Code, is amended by
- 11 amending Subsections (a) and (j) and adding Subsection (c) to read
- 12 as follows:
- 13 (a) Subject to <u>Subsection (c) and</u> Section 825.506, the
- 14 retirement system may not, under Section 824.601, withhold a
- 15 monthly benefit payment if the retiree is employed in a Texas public
- 16 educational institution:
- 17 (1) as a substitute only with pay not more than the
- 18 daily rate of substitute pay established by the employer and, if the
- 19 retiree is a disability retiree, the employment has not exceeded a
- 20 total of 90 days in the school year;
- 21 (2) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
- 22 more than a one-half time basis for the month;
- 23 (3) in one or more positions on as much as a full-time
- 24 basis, if the retiree has been separated from service with all Texas

- 1 public educational institutions for at least 12 full consecutive
- 2 months after the retiree's effective date of retirement; or
- 3 (4) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
- 4 more than a one-half time basis for no more than 90 days in the
- 5 school year, if the retiree is a disability retiree.
- 6 (c) Except as provided by this subsection, an exception
- 7 provided by Subsection (a)(2) or (4) continues to apply to a retiree
- 8 who exceeds a limitation prescribed by that subsection because of
- 9 an exigent event that is beyond the retiree's control, including a
- 10 weather-related event. If the system applies this subsection to a
- 11 retiree:
- 12 <u>(1) the system shall:</u>
- (A) immediately notify the retiree and the Texas
- 14 public educational institution employing the retiree that the
- 15 retiree exceeded a limitation provided by Subsection (a)(2) or (4),
- 16 <u>as applicable; and</u>
- 17 (B) if appropriate, provide to the retiree a
- 18 30-day period from the date notice is received by the retiree in
- 19 which the retiree may take corrective action to avoid exceeding the
- 20 limitation again in the future, as prescribed by the retirement
- 21 system; and
- 22 (2) the retiree shall, in the manner prescribed by the
- 23 system:
- (A) return to the system the prorated amount of
- 25 the monthly benefit payment received by the retiree that is
- 26 attributable to the period in which the retiree exceeded the
- 27 limitation provided by Subsection (a)(2) or (4), as applicable; or

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1 (B) pay to the system the difference between the actual hours for which the retiree was compensated and the hours 2 permitted under Subsection (a)(2) or (4), as applicable. 3 4 (j) The board of trustees shall adopt rules: (1) governing the employment of a substitute; 5 6 (2) [and] defining "one-half time basis"; and (3) implementing Subsection (c), as necessary.["] 7 SECTION 3. Section 824.602, Government Code, as amended by 8 this Act, applies only to a benefit payment made by the Teacher 9 Retirement System of Texas that becomes payable on or after the 10 11 effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
