## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 243.008(e), Human Resources Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(e) Not later than January 31 of each even-numbered year,
9	the department shall submit a report to the governor, the
10	lieutenant governor, and each member of the legislature [the
11	speaker of the house of representatives, and each standing
12	committee having primary jurisdiction over the department]. The
13	department shall also make the report available to the public on the
14	department's Internet website. The report must summarize
15	statistical information concerning the total number and percentage
16	of children in the custody of the department during the preceding
17	two years who have at any time been in foster care. Data in the
18	report must be disaggregated by:
19	<u>(1) age;</u>
20	(2) sex;
21	<pre>(3) race or ethnicity;</pre>
22	(4) the conduct for which children were committed to
23	the department; and
24	(5) children entering the juvenile justice system for

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
