5	SECTION 1. Section 25.093, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-2) to read as
7	follows:
8	(c) An offense under Subsection (a) is a misdemeanor,
9	punishable by <u>a</u> fine [only,] in an amount not to exceed:
10	(1) $\$250$ and by not less than eight hours of community
11	<u>service</u> [\$100] for a first offense;
12	(2) <u>\$350 and by not less than 16 hours of community</u>
13	<pre>service [\$200] for a second offense;</pre>
14	(3) $\frac{$450}{100}$ and by not less than 24 hours of community
15	<u>service</u> [\$300] for a third offense; <u>or</u>
16	(4) [\$400 for a fourth offense; or
17	[(5)] \$500 <u>and by not less than 32 hours of community</u>
18	<u>service</u> for a <u>fourth</u> [fifth] or subsequent offense.
19	(c-2) A defendant required to perform community service
20	under this section after conviction of an offense under Subsection
21	(a) shall perform school-based community service in the county in
22	which the defendant resides.
23	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
24	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 4 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 6 before that date.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
