- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 402.007(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The total amount credited to the judicial fund for
- 8 programs approved by the supreme court that provide basic civil
- 9 legal services to the indigent under Subsection (b) may not exceed
- 10 \$50 million per state fiscal year [biennium].
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
