A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

<u>L</u>	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the presence of a minor on the premises of a sexually
- 3 oriented business that is permitted or licensed under the Alcoholic
- 4 Beverage Code; creating a criminal offense.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 106, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 106.17 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 106.17. PRESENCE OF MINOR ON PERMITTED OR LICENSED
- 9 PREMISES OPERATING AS A SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESS. (a) A minor
- 10 may not be on premises covered by a permit or license issued under
- 11 this code if a sexually oriented business, as defined by Section
- 12 <u>243.002</u>, Local Government Code, operates on the premises.
- 13 (b) The holder of a permit or license covering a premises
- 14 described by Subsection (a) may not knowingly or recklessly allow a
- 15 minor to be on the premises.
- 16 <u>(c) The holder of a permit or license who violates</u>
- 17 Subsection (b) commits an offense. An offense under this
- 18 subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
