## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 692A.005(b), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) A donor or other person authorized to make an anatomical 7 gift under Section 692A.004 may make a gift by a donor card or other 8 record signed by the donor or other person making the gift or by
- 9 authorizing that a statement or symbol indicating the donor has
- 10 made an anatomical gift be included on a donor registry. If the
- 11 donor or other person is physically unable to sign a record, the
- 12 record may be signed by another individual at the direction of the
- 13 donor or other person and must:
- 14 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 15 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request
- 16 of the donor or the other person, or be acknowledged before a notary
- 17 public; and
- 18 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 19 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- SECTION 2. Section 692A.006(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (b) A record signed pursuant to Subsection (a)(1)(C) must:
- 23 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 24 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request

- 1 of the donor or the other person, or be acknowledged before a notary
- 2 public; and
- 3 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 4 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 692A.007(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A record signed pursuant to Subsection (a)(1)(B) must:
- 8 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 9 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request
- 10 of the individual, or be acknowledged before a notary public; and
- 11 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 12 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- 13 SECTION 4. Chapter 692, Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 repealed.
- 15 SECTION 5. Sections 692A.005, 692A.006, and 692A.007,
- 16 Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to the
- 17 validity of a document executed on or after the effective date of
- 18 this Act. The validity of a document executed before the effective
- 19 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 20 document was executed, and that law continues in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 6. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this
- 23 section, the changes in law made by this Act apply to:
- 24 (1) a record described by Section 692A.005, 692A.006,
- or 692A.007, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, created
- 26 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act; and
- 27 (2) a judicial proceeding concerning a record

- 4 (B) is pending on the effective date of this Act.
- (b) If the court finds that application of a provision of this Act would substantially interfere with the effective conduct of a judicial proceeding concerning a record described by Subsection (a)(1) of this section that is pending on the effective date of this Act or prejudice the rights of a party to the proceeding, the provision of this Act does not apply, and the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act applies in
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
