- 11 (1) clerical errors that affect a property owner's

- 13 (2) multiple appraisals of a property in that tax
- 14 year;
- 15 (3) the inclusion of property that does not exist in
- 16 the form or at the location described in the appraisal roll; [or]
- 17 (4) an error in which property is shown as owned by a
- 18 person who did not own the property on January 1 of that tax year; or
- 19 <u>(5)</u> an error in the square footage of a residence
- 20 <u>homestead described in the appraisal roll, but only if the error</u>
- 21 resulted in square footage that exceeds the correct square footage
- 22 of the residence homestead by more than 10 percent.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
