## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to uncollectible fees and costs in criminal actions and

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Articles 103.0081(b) and (c), Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) On a finding by a court that any condition described by
- 8 Subsections (a)(1)-(3) is true, the court may order the officer to
- 9 designate the fee or item of cost as uncollectible in the fee record
- 10 and enter an order forgiving the outstanding fee or item of cost and
- 11 closing the case. The officer shall attach a copy of the court's
- 12 order to the fee record.
- 13 (c) The trial court in which a criminal action or proceeding
- 14 was held may, on the court's own motion, make the finding described
- 15 by Subsection (a) and enter an order forgiving an outstanding fee or
- 16 item of cost imposed in the action or proceeding and closing the
- 17 case [This article applies only to a county with a population of
- 18 more than 780,000 but less than 790,000].
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
