A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to public notice of the time for voting at an early voting 3 polling place.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 85.067(c), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (c) The schedule shall be posted continuously for a period beginning not later than the fifth day before the first day of the 8 9 period for early voting by personal appearance and ending on the last day of that period. The schedule may be amended after the 10 11 beginning of early voting by personal appearance to include notice 12 of additional temporary branch polling place locations, dates, and hours[, but any amendment must be made not later than the fifth day 13 14 before the date the voting is scheduled to begin at the additional temporary branch]. 15

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
