## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the placement of a slow-moving-vehicle emblem.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 547.703(a), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a slow-moving
- 7 vehicle shall display a slow-moving-vehicle emblem that:
- 8 (1) has a reflective surface designed to be clearly
- 9 visible in daylight or at night from the light of standard
- 10 automobile headlamps at a distance of at least 500 feet;
- 11 (2) is mounted base down on the rear of the vehicle and
- 12 at a height that does not impair the visibility of the emblem [from
- 13 three to five feet above the road surface]; and
- 14 (3) is maintained in a clean, reflective condition.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 22 committed before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
