Except as provided by Subsection (e) or Subchapter C, 9 Chapter 20, an application must be submitted by personal delivery, 10 by mail, or by telephonic facsimile machine in accordance with 11 12 Sections 13.143(d) and (d-2). SECTION 2. Section 20.062, Election Code, is amended by 13 14 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: (d) A procedure prescribed under this section must provide 15 for the electronic transmission of <u>an applicant's voter</u> 16 registration data by the department to the secretary of state in 17 accordance with Section 20.066. 18 SECTION 3. Sections 20.063(a) and (c), Election Code, are 19 20 amended to read as follows: 21 (a) The Department of Public Safety shall provide to each person who applies in person, by mail, or online at the department's 22 23 Internet website [at the department's offices] for an original or renewal of a driver's license, a personal identification card, or a 24

1 duplicate or corrected license or card an opportunity to complete a

3 (c) A change of address that relates to a license or card and 4 that is submitted to the department in person, [or] by mail, or online at the department's Internet website serves as a change of 5 6 address for voter registration unless the licensee or cardholder indicates that the change is not for voter registration purposes. 7 The date of submission of a change of address to a department 8 employee is considered to be the date of submission to the voter 9 registrar for the purpose of determining the effective date of 10 registration [only]. 11
