- 8 engaged in the practice of dentistry;
- 9 (3) a licensed optometrist or therapeutic optometrist
- 10 engaged in the practice of optometry or therapeutic optometry as
- 11 defined by statute;
- 12 (4) an occupational therapist engaged in the practice
- 13 of occupational therapy;
- 14 (5) a nurse engaged in the practice of nursing;
- 15 (6) a licensed podiatrist engaged in the practice of
- 16 podiatry as defined by statute;
- 17 (7) a physical therapist engaged in the practice of
- 18 physical therapy;
- 19 (8) a registered massage therapist engaged in the
