A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the definition of a bet for purposes of gambling 3 criminal offenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 47.01, Penal Code, is amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as 6 7 follows: 8 (1) "Bet" means an agreement to win or lose something 9 of value solely or partially by chance. A bet does not include: 10 (A) contracts of indemnity or guaranty, or life, 11 health, property, or accident insurance; 12 (B) an offer of a prize, award, or compensation to the actual contestants or participants in a bona fide contest for 13 the determination of skill, speed, strength, or endurance or to the 14 owners of animals, vehicles, watercraft, or aircraft entered in a 15 16 contest; [or] (C) an offer of merchandise, with a value not 17 greater than \$25, made by the proprietor of a bona fide carnival 18 contest conducted at a carnival sponsored by a nonprofit religious, 19 fraternal, school, law enforcement, youth, agricultural, or civic 20 including any nonprofit agricultural or civic 21 group, group incorporated by the state before 1955, if the person to receive the 22 23 merchandise from the proprietor is the person who performs the 24 carnival contest; or

1 (D) an offer of a prize, award, or compensation 2 to the participants in a fantasy or simulated game or contest. (2-a) "Fantasy or simulated game or contest" means a 3 bona fide contest, reflecting the knowledge and skill of the 4 participants, in which: 5 6 (A) participants assemble a fictional sports 7 team composed of actual professional or amateur athletes to compete against other fictional sports teams assembled by other 8 participants for a prize, award, or compensation; 9 10 (B) the value of any prize, award, or compensation is established in advance of the beginning of the game 11 12 or contest; (C) the outcome of the game or contest is 13 14 determined by the accumulated statistical performances of the 15 individual athletes on a participant's fictional sports team; and 16 (D) the outcome of the game or contest is not 17 based solely on the score, point spread, or performance of a single professional or amateur team or athlete. 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 19 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 21 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 22 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 23 For

24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 25 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 26 before that date.
