 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the information necessary to appropriately title
 1-20 certain flood damaged vehicles that have been repaired with federal
 1-21 financial assistance.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section [501.09112](#), Transportation Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

1-25 (d-1) The department and the Texas Division of Emergency
 1-26 Management shall coordinate with the Federal Emergency Management
 1-27 Agency to ensure that the department has information, including a
 1-28 vehicle identification number, necessary to apply the notation
 1-29 under Subsection (d) to the title of a vehicle:

1-30 (1) to which that subsection applies; and
 1-31 (2) that has been repaired or salvaged using financial
 1-32 assistance designated for that purpose and administered by the
 1-33 Federal Emergency Management Agency.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
