A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the dissolution of the North Montague County Water 3 Supply District. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. (a) The directors of the North Montague County 5 Water Supply District shall wind up the affairs of the district. 6 7 (b) On December 31, 2019: (1) the North Montague County Water Supply District is 8 9 dissolved; (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire; 10 11 and 12 (3) all assets and liabilities of the district are transferred to the City of Nocona. 13 SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2020, Chapter 12, Acts of 14 the 53rd Legislature, 1st Called Session, 1954, is repealed. 15 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 16 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 17 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 18 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 19 20 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 21 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. 22 23 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 24 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on

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1 Environmental Quality.

2 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 3 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 4 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 5 representatives within the required time.

6 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 9 and accomplished.

SECTION 4. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
