- 2 relating to evidence sufficient for the issuance of a stalking
- 3 protective order.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 7A.03, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A court may not find that there are reasonable grounds
- 8 to believe that the applicant is the victim of stalking solely based
- 9 on the content of an electronic communication unless the
- 10 communication threatens harm to the applicant, a member of the
- 11 applicant's family or household, the applicant's pet or property,
- 12 or another person. For purposes of this subsection, "electronic
- 13 communication" has the meaning assigned by Section 42.07, Penal
- 14 Code.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an application for a protective order submitted on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- 20 in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
