1 AN ACT 2 relating to a prohibition on bids by certain insurance and health benefit providers to administer or provide coverage under certain 3 group benefit plans for governmental employees. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 1551.2131 to read as follows: Sec. 1551.2131. CERTAIN CARRIERS PROHIBITED FROM BIDDING. 8 9 A carrier is prohibited from submitting a bid under Section 1551.212 or 1551.213 for two competitive bidding cycles if the 10 board of trustees finds that the carrier has terminated a contract 11 with a physician or provider for the provision of services solely 12 because the physician or provider informed an enrollee in a health 13 benefit plan offered or administered by the carrier of the full 14 range of physicians and providers, including out-of-network 15 16 providers, available to the enrollee. SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, is 17 amended by adding Section 1575.1061 to read as follows: 18 Sec. 1575.1061. CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS PROHIBITED 19 FROM BIDDING. A health care provider described by Section 1575.109 20 21 is prohibited from submitting a bid under Section 1575.106 for two competitive bidding cycles if the trustee finds that the health 22 23 care provider has terminated a contract with a physician or

- 5 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1579.0541 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1579.0541. CERTAIN HEALTH CARE AND BENEFIT PROVIDERS
- 8 PROHIBITED FROM BIDDING. A health care or benefit provider is
- 9 prohibited from submitting a bid under Section 1579.054 for two
- 10 competitive bidding cycles if the trustee finds that the health
- 11 care or benefit provider has terminated a contract with a physician
- 12 or provider for the provision of services solely because the
- 13 physician or provider informed an enrollee in a health coverage
- 14 plan offered or administered by the health care or benefit provider
- 15 of the full range of physicians and providers, including
- 16 <u>out-of-network providers</u>, available to the enrollee.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
