2 (5) notwithstanding Subsection (a)(1), conduct
3 described by Section 43.02(a) or (b), Penal Code; [or]

4 (6) notwithstanding Subsection (a)(1), conduct that 5 violates Section 43.261, Penal Code; or

6 (7) notwithstanding Subsection (a)(1), conduct 7 described by Section 38.04, Penal Code, that:

8 (A) is punishable as a Class A misdemeanor under
9 that section; and

10 (B) only consists of intentionally fleeing a 11 person the child knows is a peace officer or federal special 12 investigator attempting lawfully to detain the child.

13 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to conduct that occurs on 14 or after the effective date of this Act. Conduct that occurs before 15 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on 16 the date the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in 17 effect for that purpose. For the purposes of this section, conduct 18 occurred before the effective date of this Act if any element of the 19 conduct occurred before that date.
