## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the accrual of interest on annuity and other payments
- 3 made to certain retirees who have resumed employment within the
- 4 Texas Municipal Retirement System.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 852.108(f) and (j), Government Code,
- 7 are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (f) Monthly payments of a suspended annuity shall be resumed
- 9 in the month following the month in which employment is terminated
- 10 with the reemploying municipality and recomputed to reflect the
- 11 <u>accumulation of interest</u>, [without change in the amount except for]
- 12 any increase allowed under Section 854.203, and [ex] the duration
- 13 of or another condition pertaining to the suspended benefit. Except
- 14 as provided by Subsection (j), payment of the resumed benefit may
- 15 not be made for any month during which the payment was suspended
- 16 under this section.
- 17 (j) A person to whom this section applies shall receive a
- 18 lump-sum payment in an amount equal to the sum of the service
- 19 retirement annuity payments the person would have received had the
- 20 person's annuity payments not been discontinued and suspended under
- 21 this section, plus accumulated interest, if the person:
- 22 (1) initially retired based on a bona fide termination
- 23 of employment; and
- 24 (2) resumed employment with the person's reemploying

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- 1 municipality at least eight years after the effective date of the
- 2 person's retirement.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to a member of the Texas Municipal Retirement System who terminates
- 5 employment with the person's reemploying municipality and files an
- 6 application for resumption of retirement with the board of trustees
- 7 of the Texas Municipal Retirement System under Section 852.108,
- 8 Government Code, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective
- 9 date of this Act. A member who terminates employment with the
- 10 person's reemploying municipality and files an application for
- 11 resumption of retirement with the board under Section 852.108,
- 12 Government Code, before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 13 by the law as it existed immediately before that date, and the
- 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
