A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishment of the office of first responder training
- 3 support within the Bill Blackwood Law Enforcement Management
- 4 Institute of Texas and to the provision of critical incident
- 5 support training services to first responders.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 96, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 96.642 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 96.642. OFFICE OF FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING SUPPORT.
- 10 (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Critical incident stress management team" means a
- 12 trained team of peer support responders and mental health
- 13 professionals who provide support to first responders using an
- 14 integrated multicomponent crisis intervention system.
- 15 (2) "Department" means Disaster Behavioral Health
- 16 Services within the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 17 (3) "First responder" has the meaning assigned by
- 18 <u>Section 421.095</u>, <u>Government Code</u>.
- 19 <u>(4) "Institute" means the Bill Blackwood Law</u>
- 20 <u>Enforcement Management Institute of Texas.</u>
- 21 (5) "Office" means the office of first responder
- 22 training support established by this section.
- 23 (6) "Peer support responder" means an individual
- 24 member of a peer support team who, as an employee, contractor, or

- 1 volunteer of a public agency, provides services designed to give
- 2 compassionate or coping support to a first responder involved in,
- 3 witness to, or otherwise affected by a traumatic event.
- 4 (7) "President" means the president of Sam Houston
- 5 State University.
- 6 (8) "Public agency" has the meaning assigned by
- 7 Section 2257.002, Government Code.
- 8 (b) The president shall establish an office of first
- 9 responder training support within the institute.
- 10 (c) The president shall appoint a training support
- 11 coordinator as the administrative head of the office. Except as
- 12 provided by Subsection (d), the training support coordinator must:
- 13 (1) have at least five years of experience as a first
- 14 responder;
- 15 (2) have successfully completed training in providing
- 16 critical incident stress management to first responders; and
- 17 (3) demonstrate a professional ability to provide
- 18 emotional and moral support to first responders.
- 19 (d) If the training support coordinator has not completed
- 20 the training required by Subsection (c)(2), the training support
- 21 coordinator must complete the training as soon as practicable.
- (e) The office may coordinate with the department to
- 23 establish a program for training individuals to serve on a critical
- 24 incident stress management team. An individual may not serve on a
- 25 critical incident stress management team before the individual
- 26 completes training in critical incident stress management at least
- 27 as comprehensive as that provided by the International Critical

- 1 <u>Incident Stress Foundation.</u>
- 2 (f) The office shall provide assistance in gaining access to
- 3 training at least as comprehensive as that provided by the
- 4 International Critical Incident Stress Foundation for critical
- 5 incident stress management teams. The training courses may include
- 6 instruction about:
- 7 <u>(1) suicide awareness;</u>
- 8 (2) suicide prevention;
- 9 <u>(3) suicide intervention for first resp</u>onders; and
- 10 (4) other behavioral health topics.
- 11 (g) The office shall provide information about the
- 12 department's critical incident stress management teams to an
- 13 individual who completes the office's training.
- 14 (h) The office and department shall share with first
- 15 responders who have been involved in a critical incident
- 16 information regarding the availability of the Post Critical
- 17 Incident Seminar.
- 18 (i) The office shall coordinate with qualified
- 19 International Critical Incident Stress Foundation instructors to
- 20 provide International Critical Incident Stress Foundation training
- 21 to peer support responders.
- (j) The office may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 23 donations to implement this section.
- 24 (k) The president shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 25 this section.
- 26 (1) This section does not place any restrictions on the type
- 27 of training provided by or to any critical incident stress

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- 1 management team or peer support program outside of the institute.
- 2 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 3 of this Act, the president of Sam Houston State University shall
- 4 adopt rules necessary to implement Section 96.642, Education Code,
- 5 as added by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
