10	punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 or more than \$750.
11	(g-1) In lieu of imposing a fine on conviction under
12	Subsection (g), the court may order a person who has not previously
13	been convicted of an offense under this section to:
14	(1) perform community service at a nonprofit
15	organization that serves persons with disabilities or persons with
16	disabling diseases;
17	(2) perform any community service that may sensitize
18	the person to the needs of and obstacles faced by persons with
19	disabilities; or
20	(3) attend education classes on disability awareness
21	and accessible parking.
22	(g-2) The court shall set the number of hours of community
23	service or education classes required under Subsection (g-1).
24	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to

an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
